# **Doctoral Research and Conference Travel Grant Application**

The Department of Art History Travel Grant is designed to provide PhD students with financial assistance in order to pursue travel that is necessary for their research program and in direct support of the completion of their dissertation.

## Eligibility

To be eligible for this award, students must be registered and in good academic standing in the academic session in which the travel takes place. Applicants must provide a brief but detailed statement regarding the nature and need for travel, as it directly pertains to their doctoral research. Other research/travel funding available to students will be taken into account in the evaluation of each application. Preference will be given to first-time applicants.

### Value

Grant amounts vary depending upon the nature and location of research. We request that all students who are undertaking doctoral research travel apply for extra-departmental funding. Please consult FAS, SGS, and other sources for funding opportunities.
